EXTRACT FROM CLUB RULES

Any person who shall have attained the age of eighteen years and who shall have attended three Club meets (this includes weekend, mid-week walking and mid-week climbing meets) and who shall have completed an application form shall be eligible for election as a Member of the Club.

Ordinary Membership Any person eligible for Membership shall duly become a Member provided that he or she is proposed and seconded by Members of the Club who shall have signed the application form, and three quarters of the Committee present and voting cast their votes in favour of ... election.

Entrance fee of and subscription The entrance fee and annual subscription shall be such sums as may be determined from time to time at an Annual General Meeting ... and shall be paid within one month of the date of notification of election to membership.

The present **subscription** is £20.00 (£15.00 for Retired / Student / Unemployed members) with an initial **entrance fee** of £1.00 to cover postage costs.
